- 4. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Do you want us to know anything else about you as a candidate? (If you are re-applying, please articulate what have you worked on to improve) (Optional) (<250 words)

2. Coursework: DES 2630 - Design Context

Include Design Lab final project

- Include relevant project information, descriptions and your final design images and text
- Please show your design process! Lab instructors should walk you through this.
- Overall, remember to develop and craft your presentation of the project into a clear narrative

Include Sketchbook exercises: select 3 to 5 assignments (for example sketchbook exercises, collage, photography)

3. Coursework: ARCH 2630 - Arch Workshop

Include 2 – 3 projects / examples of work from this course. Include process work where applicable.

4. Other work - OPTIONAL

Adding other design / creative work is completely optional. Applicants who do not include other work will not be disadvantaged. Select and show your strongest work only:

- Other University of Utah design courses e.g. graphic design, communications, art courses
- Other work completed outside university (speak to your DES2630 instructor for advice on this!)
